TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATION AND PAYMENTS: All reservation forms must be accompanied by a deposit of \$500 per person. Full payment is due by January 15th, 2018. Checks for the entire package should be made payable to Galilee Travel, Inc.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: Sightseeing is included per itinerary provided. We feature hotels specifically selected for our tours. Occasionally we are obliged to make substitutions. All hotels offer us standard grade (run of the house) rooms. If you are arriving at a hotel before mid-day, your room may not be ready on arrival. Package is based on double occupancy. Single rooms are often limited. We can also try to match you with a roommate when and if possible. We can only assign a roommate if another person on the tour wishes to share. If we cannot assign a roommate, the single supplement will be invoiced.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Package includes airfare.

MEALS: Arranged meals are detailed in the itinerary.

TRANSFERS: Transfers are offered based on the itinerary. Passengers arriving and departing not per our trip's schedule are responsible for their own transfers.

TIPPING: Package includes all tips.

INSURANCE: Insurance is not included in any tour package. **INSURANCE IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.** Please note that we cannot accept responsibility for any losses or expenses which you or any member of your party may incur as a result of failing to secure adequate coverage. Galilee Travel recommends Travelex Insurance. Please ask for details and forms.

MEDICAL CONDITION: Galilee Travel is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

PASSPORT AND VISAS: A valid passport is required for all participants. It must be valid for 6 months from the day of your return to the US or the airline may refuse you boarding. There is no Visa requirement for citizens of the USA travelling to Israel. Other nationals should contact the appropriate consulate for regulations.

CANCELLATION: Cancellations must be received in writing and signed by the client.

- \$100 per person if cancelled after December 15, 2017.
- \$250 per person if cancelled 90-61 days prior to departure
- \$500 per person if cancelled 60-30 days prior to departure
- 100% penalty if cancelled 30 days or less prior to departure
- **REFUND POLICY:** Refunds for cancellations received less than 2 months prior to group departure will be processed only after the group returns.

BAGGAGE: Travelers are limited to one large suitcase per person plus a carry on. Airlines are constantly updating their luggage requirements and policies and we strongly advise that you check with your airline before departure in order to avoid additional charges. Luggage is the responsibility of the passenger. For lost luggage claims, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Baggage insurance is recommended.

NOT INCLUDED: Meals or beverages not specified in the itinerary, all gratuities, airport taxes, optional tours, charges for passports, visas, laundry, liquor, excess baggage charges, accident and baggage insurance, telephone or cable charges, private non-group transfer, items of a personal nature and any items not specifically listed as included.

RESPONSIBILITY: Galilee Travel is acting solely as an intermediary agent for the travel suppliers providing means of transportation, hotel and/or all other related travel services being purchased (the "Third Party Providers"). Galilee Travel therefore, shall not be liable or responsible for any injury, illness, loss or damage to any person or property or additional expense involved with travel resulting from acts of God, detention, annoyance, delays, quarantine, strikes, thefts, pilferage, force majeure, diseases, mechanical difficulties, failure of any means of transportation to arrive or depart as scheduled, civil disturbances, terrorism, government restrictions or regulations, and discrepancies or changes in transportation or hotel services or any other matter or event over which Galilee Travel has no control; or for any state of quality, hygiene, political, stability, cuisine, sanitation facilities, cleanliness, telecommunications facilities, methods of conducting business, emergency medical evacuation, treatment or medical services existing at any travel destination. By embarking upon his/her travel, the passenger voluntarily assumes all risks involved with such travel, whether expected or unexpected. The issuance and acceptance of any exchange orders or tickets shall constitute consent by the purchase and/or passenger to the foregoing conditions. All exchange orders and tickets are also subject to such additional terms and conditions as the Third Party Providers may impose. Finally, Galilee Travel shall not be liable for any funds received from the purchaser and/or passenger and paid over to any Third Party Provider which subsequently becomes insolvent or files any bankruptcy or similar proceedings or fails to deliver services.

Delays, cancellations and overbooking by participating Third Party Providers may occur on air flights and land reservations. While Galilee Travel will do its utmost to avoid these inconveniences, it shall not be liable or responsible for the acts or omissions of such Third Party Providers.

Galilee Travel reserves the right (i) to cancel any tour, substitute hotels and make such alterations in tour itineraries as may be necessary or desirable for the convenience of the parties and the proper carrying out of the tour; and (ii) to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of any tour. All additional cost, if necessary, shall be the passenger's responsibility. In addition, Galilee Travel may cancel any tour prior to departure. In such a case, a full refund of all payments will constitute full settlement with the passenger and/or purchaser of the tour.
